Conditions of Entry

1. Entrants must be under the age of 18 years at 00.00 on 1st January in year of competition and hold an authorised handicap – limit 28 for boys and 36 for girls.

Handicap certificates will be required on day of competition.

2. Entries will be limited to first 84 entries received. A reserve list will be maintained.

NOTE: No entry fee will normally be refunded after the Starting Sheet has been posted. Any refund will be at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

Conditions of Play

1. a) The Burford Junior Open will be played over 36 holes stroke play in one day.
b) The winner shall be the competitor (boy or girl) who returns the lowest gross score over 36 holes. In the event of a tie a count-back will determine the winner. (see 1d)
c) Handicap prizes will be determined on count-back.(see 1d)
Note: girls will receive an addition of strokes to their handicap to reflect the difference between the SSS of the men's(White Tee) and ladies' (Red Tee) courses.
d) All tied scores will be decided on the last 18, last 9, last 6, last 3 or last hole, in that order. If a tie still results then the preceding round shall be treated in the same manner.
e) No competitor may win more than one main prize.
2. This event is a 'Qualifying competition' for handicap purposes.
3. **No one over the age of 18 years may act as a caddie for any competitor.**
4. Rulings may only be obtained from delegated officials. If there is any doubt and a ruling is not immediately available, a competitor may proceed under Rule 3-3 of the Rules of Golf.
5. Any dispute will be settled by the Competition Committee of the day.
6. Local Rules other than on card will if necessary be available on the day.
7. If weather interferes with play over two rounds, the Organising Committee may vary the Conditions of Play (1a)

DRESS

Boys should wear jacket/blazer and tie for prize presentation and girls be dressed appropriately.
